MEXICO WINDPOWER 2018 CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Mexico WindPower is the most influential annual event in the wind industry in Mexico and the event is co-organized by Amdee (Mexican Wind Power Association), GWEC (Global Wind Energy Council) and EJ Krause de Mexico. 2018 will mark the 7th event of its kind in Mexico and it will be held from 28th February to 1st March, with policy, technical and market tracks now open a call for abstracts.

B. Requirements for the submission

1. Deadlines for submission:

- 31 October 2017: deadline for submitting abstracts (or the full paper if possible);
- 1st - 10th November, 2017: authors will be notified as to the acceptance of their papers;
- 11th Nov - 1st Dec, 2017: deadline for full paper submission

2. Submission requirement:

- Abstract can be both in English and/or Spanish. Full papers can be either in English or Spanish;
- Please provide bio(s) of the author(s) and contact information;
- Please refer to the annex below for the format requirements of the submission;

3. How will the accepted papers be utilized?

- Accepted papers will be available for downloading by MWP conference delegates; abstracts of the accepted paper will be uploaded to the MWP website and therefore accessible to the public;
- A selected number of authors will be invited to speak at relevant sessions of the conference;
- Posters will be done by presenters according to Organizing Committee requirements

Abstract: (Times New Roman, Font size 11, less than 400 words)

Key words: (Times New Roman, Font size 11, less than 5 words)

(Text)

1. Page margins: 2.5cm;
2. Times New Roman, Font size 11, less than 6 pages;
3. Unit of measurement: SI units;
4. References should be listed alphabetically or numbered consecutively at the end of the paper;
5. The abstract and the paper should be submitted in Word format.
