MEXICO WINDPOWER 2018 CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Mexico Wind Power is the most influential annual event in the wind industry in Mexico and the event is co-organized by Amdee (Mexican Wind Power Association), GWEC (Global Wind Energy Association) and EKJ Krause de Mexico. 2018 will mark the 7th event of its kind in Mexico and it will be held 28th February to 1st March, with policy, technical and market tracks now open for abstracts.

B. Requirements for the submission

1. Deadlines for submission:

- 30th September 2017: deadline for submitting abstracts (or the full paper if possible);
- 1st - 10th October, 2017: authors will be notified as to the acceptance of their papers;
- 11th Oct - 1st Nov, 2017: deadline for full paper submission

2. Submission requirement:

- Abstract can be both in English and/or Spanish. Full papers can be either in English or Spanish;
- Please provide bio(s) of the author(s) and contact information;
- Please refer to the annex below for the format requirements of the submission;

3. How will the accepted papers be utilized?

- Accepted papers will be available for downloading by MWP conference delegates; abstracts of the accepted paper will be uploaded to the MWP website and therefore accessible to the public;
- A selected number of authors will be invited to speak at relevant sessions of the conference;
- A selection of the accepted papers will be accepted as posters and placed in the designated Poster Area of the expo floor during MWP.

1. Page margins : 2.5cm;
2. Times New Roman, Font size 11, less than 6 pages;
3. Unit of measurement : SI units;
4. References should be listed alphabetically or numbered consecutively at the end of the paper;
5. The abstract and the paper should be submitted in Word format.
