



### CWP2018 Call for Abstracts

China Wind Power (CWP) is one of the most influential events in the wind industry. The event is co-organized by five leading organizations: Chinese Wind Energy Association (CWEA), Chinese Renewable Energy Industries Association (CREIA), Global Wind Energy Council (GWEC), China National Renewable Energy Centre (CNREC) and China Wind Energy Equipment Association (CWEEA). The event has hosted 10 events since its debut in 2008.

CWP 2018 will be held on 17<sup>th</sup> -19<sup>th</sup> October and the technical, policy and market tracks are now open for abstracts.

#### A. Tracks for Abstract

1. Innovative technologies in terms of design, manufacturing and testing of wind turbines and its components (onshore and offshore), leading to cost reduction and production optimization.
2. Onshore and offshore wind resources assessment, siting, base design and construction, logistics, transportation and installation of components;
3. Wind Farm O&M technologies and business models.
4. IT and IOT technology application in wind farm O&M: wind forecast; balancing service and IT technology; wind and micro grid.
5. Economic, environment and socio-economic benefits of wind; clean energy and its contribution to air pollution abatement; energy transition and its challenges;
6. Major global renewable/wind policy trend; market and investment trend analysis; RPS and Green certificate system: its application in China and in other countries.
7. China electricity market reform analysis: experiences from outside China.

## **B. Requirements for the submission**

1. Deadlines for submission:

- June 30, 2018: deadline for submitting abstracts (or the full paper if possible);
- July 1 - 10, 2018: authors will be notified as to the acceptance of their papers;
- July 10 - August 20, 2018: deadline for full paper submission

2. Submission requirement:

- Abstract can be both in English and/or Chinese. Full papers can be either in English or Chinese;
- Please provide bio(s) of the author(s) and contact information;
- Please refer to the attachment for the format requirements of the submission;
- Papers that are submitted last year but were not selected are not able to be re-submitted this year, unless there is a considerable update. Accepted papers will be uploaded to the CWP website and be available for downloading by CWP conference participants.

**3.** How will the accepted papers be utilized?

- Accepted papers will be available for downloading by CWP conference delegates; abstracts of the accepted paper will be uploaded to the CWP website and therefore accessible to the public;
- A selected number of authors will be invited to speak at relevant sessions of the conference;
- A selection of the accepted papers will be submitted to Wind Energy magazine (reference number: CN11-5942/TK) for future publications.

**Abstract:** (Times New Roman, Font size 11, rowledge 16, less than 400 words)

**Key words:** (Times New Roman, Font size 11, rowledge 16, less than 5 words)

**(Text)**

1. Page margins: 2.5cm;
2. Times New Roman, Font size 11,rowledge 20, less than 6 pages;
3. Unit of measurement: SI units;
4. References should be listed alphabetically or numbered consecutively at the end of the paper;
5. The abstract and the paper should be submitted in **Word** format.
